- Forces definition of concrete/achievable goals to realize an inspirational vision
- Helps identify and prioritize needed activities, based on cost and impact
- Provides key metrics and checkpoints to measure whether or not, and how:
 - You're on track to achieve your goals
 - You're applying your limited resources most effectively
- Proof of Concept/Selling Document for Funders and Board

•Supportive regulatory and tax environment


Costs & Funding

Taking Inventory: "SWOT" Analysis

Strengths

Assets at your disposal

"Build On"

Weaknesses

Gaps in abilities and/or resources

"Shore Up"

Opportunities

Advantages/Needs

"Capitalize"

Threats

Challenges or unfavorable trends

"Recognize"

External

Critical look at organization, available resources, factors that affect ability to set, prioritize and achieve goals.

Internal



How to Use Plan

- Monitor activity and progress internally for resource allocation
- Assess effectiveness of activities and make adjustments as necessary
- Communicate with funders
- Keep staff and stakeholders focused on core objectives
